Acknowledgement of envisaged Cooperation between Pantarei Divinitus Commodity Trading Enterprises (Pty) Ltd. and the Namibia Wild Horses Foundation

This letter serves to inform the MEFT that a meeting between Pantarei Divinitus Commodity Trading Enterprises (Pty) Ltd. (thereafter called PDCTE) and 2 directors of the Namibia Wild Horses Foundation (NWHF) took place on the 17th of January 2021.

Based on a proposal document presented to MEFT and MME in 2020, Pantarei communicated its interest of collaboration to the benefit of the wild horses at Garub.

The proposal document was acknowledged and stamped by MEFT on the 7th of September 2020 and such document was presented to the Namibia Wild Horses Foundation during the meeting.

PDCTE indicated its interest in providing financial support to the maintenance of the wild horse population, to research, monitoring and special projects with regard to ensuring the long-term survival of said horse population. PDCTE's goal is to help foster conservation and protection of the population.

While no detail working relationship and course of action have been established as yet, both parties indicated their interest in collaboration and are looking forward to a fruitful cooperation.
